

# MICHIGAN STATE MUZZLE LOADING ASSOCIATION STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

## 2022 RULES

- N.M.L.R.A. Range Rules current Edition will be used at all times except as noted " \* ". You need not be a N.M.L.R.A. member to shoot.
- Black Powder or black powder substitute. No loading directly from a powder container, use a measure. Powder containers MUST be covered or closed when not being used.
- Junior's must be 15 and under as of shoot date.
- NO intoxicating beverages or smoking on the firing line or the loading line AT ANY TIME. NO LOADED FIREARM shall be taken from the firing line, see RANGE OFFICER for assistance, they can remove the charge.
- Safety shields must be used on all Flintlock Bench and Flintlock Cross-stick matches. **SUCH SHIELDS MUST BE PROVIDED BY THE SHOOTER..**
- Relays will run from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday. 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. on Sunday. No relays will begin after 11:00 a.m. on Sunday. (At the discretion of the Executive board, shoot times may change)
- Relay Time: 30 minutes. Bench rest matches: 2 consecutive relays. No Primitive matches will be shot on Sunday.
- Your State Matches are not squaded. This gives you the opportunity to shoot the matches of your choice during any day of the State Shoot. Last day for all relays will be Sunday. Each shooter is responsible for his or her own targets. You are responsible for posting and retrieving targets. **Targets left posted for more than one relay will be disqualified by the Range Officer.**
- • Only ONE (1) Buffalo Match target may be posted per relay. No other targets may be posted by the same competitor at the same distance as the buffalo match target. 14 lb. limit on buffalo guns.
- CROSS STICK MATCHES ARE TO BE SHOT PER NMLRA RULE #5340. SITTING POSITION, USING A PAD NO MORE THAN 2 INCHES THICK, AND RIFLE SUPPORTED BY THE CROSS STICKS.
- All matches to be patched round ball except pistol/revolver, musket or in-line matches.
- NO SABOTS (PLASTIC PATCHES)
- It is allowable to reserve a particular position for several relays if needed. However, please cooperate by getting your targets in early every relay and moving your equipment off the line when you are done. We need your help and support. If you have or see a problem, SEE the Range Officer at ONCE. Don't wait and then holler.
- Must use at least 5 chambers of revolver for all revolver matches.
- If you are a trader or have Muzzle loading items for sale you are welcome to set up a table or spread a blanket, however you must be registered. You must be registered to camp on the grounds during the State Matches
- **SIGHT CHANGES AND CLEANING OF THE FIREARM IS PERMITTED BETWEEN RELAYS; HOWEVER, THE BUTT OF THE FIREARM IS TO BE GROUNDED**
- **ALL FIREARMS USED IN THE FOLLOWING MATCHES: "KEELER AGGREGATES", "KID'S REST MATCHES", "MUSKET", "LIGHT BENCH MATCHES", "BUFFALO MATCHES", "TRADE GUN MATCHES", "NOVICE MATCH" MUST BE WEIGHED AND/OR MARKED BEFORE MATCHES ARE FIRED.**
- **AGGREGATE TROPHIES ARE FOR MICHIGAN RESIDENTS ONLY.**
- **ALL ADULT ASSOCIATION MEMBERS ARE EXPECTED TO HELP DURING THE STATE SHOOT.**
- **CELL PHONE or ELECTRONIC CIGARETTE USE IS NOT PERMITTED BEYOND THE SPECTATOR FENCE.**
- **SHOOTERS RESPONSIBILITY:**
  - (1) Assign and reserve your own shooting position.
  - (2) Posting and pulling your own targets.
  - (3) Marking date, position and relay number on each target posted.
  - (4) Make sure you have the correct target and that it is properly marked.

**KITCHEN:** Kitchen will be open 7:00am – 2:00pm Wednesday-Saturday, 7:00am -1:30pm Sunday (Breakfast & Lunch)

Coffee, soda and water available until 7pm, via honor system.

**REGISTRATION:** \$30.00 per family, \$20.00 per Single shooter. Novice Aggregate only \$10.00 per family, \$5.00 per single shooter. Children 19 years and older must pay own registration. Camping permitted on the club grounds. (Electric Fee\$15 Week or \$3/night - Limited Electrical, NO AIR). NOTE: Dogs must be leashed at all times. No dogs are allowed on the firing line at any time. Dog owners are responsible for the cleanup for their dogs.

**MUZZLE UP AT ALL TIMES BETWEEN LOADING BENCH AND FIRING LINE**

**PRIME OR CAP AT FIRING LINE ONLY**

**POWDER IS TO BE COVERED AFTER LOADING (CAN OR HORN)**

**POWDER MEASURE IS TO BE USED FOR LOADING YOUR FIREARM**

**NO LOADING DIRECTLY FROM FLASK, HORN OR CAN**

**FLASH SHIELDS ARE TO BE USED IN ALL FLINT BENCH AND FLINT CROSS STICK MATCHES**

**STAY BEHIND FIRING LINE AT ALL TIMES UNTIL TOLD TO GO FORWARD BY RO**

**AS A COURTESY SAY "FLINT" BEFORE FIRING A FLINTLOCK FIREARM**

**WRITE DATE, RELAY NUMBER AND SHOOTING POSITION ON ALL TARGETS**

**FIRST CAP SNAPPED SHOULD BE SHOULDERED AND POINTED DOWN RANGE**

**NO SMOKING OR VAPES ALLOWED BEYOND SPECTATOR FENCE**

**NO CELL PHONE USAGE BEYOND SPECTATOR FENCE**

**BLOW OUTS SHOULD BE PERFORMED BY RO**

## **PRIMITIVE MATCHES**

- MATCH 100.** TRADE GUN WOODS WALK. To consist of 10 targets shot on the primitive range. Flintlock only, Smooth bore, No rear sight above the plane of the barrel, patched round ball only, no set triggers. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place medals. (Primitive dress encouraged but, not required).
- MATCH 101.** NORMAN BLAKER. Trade Gun, Flintlock only, smooth bore. No set triggers, no rear sight above plane of barrel. Match consists of 5 shots at iron silhouette targets from 20 yards to 60 yards, distance unknown, throw hawk or knife at crossed strings while holding gun. 3 clay birds from a stump trap. Total score used. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place medals. One hammer fall constitutes a shot. (Primitive dress encouraged but, not required)
- MATCH 102.** James 'MAC' Hall WOODS WALK. Percussion or Flintlock, any iron sight. 7 shots at silhouettes. (Primitive dress encouraged but, not required).
- MATCH 104.** FREE TRAPPER. Percussion or flintlock, any iron sights, 5 shots in 5 positions (OH, kneeling, sitting, prone, x-sticks). Only one sighting shot is permitted. 50 yd 6 bull target at approximately 50 yards. (Primitive dress encouraged but, not required).
- MATCH 106.** FER-DU-LAC. Off hand. Percussion or Flintlock, any iron sight. 5 shots (1 shot each on two 50 yd bulls, 2 shots on one 100 yd bull, one shot on split 100 yd bull) (must be posted with small bulls up). (Primitive dress encouraged but, not required).
- MATCH 107.** Wes O'Dell KNIFE THROW. 10 Throws, 5" white bull = 5 points, 12" black bull = 4 points, any stick = 3 points. Knife must make one full turn. (Primitive dress encouraged but, not required).
- MATCH 108.** TOMAHAWK THROW. 10 Throws, same scoring as knife. Hawk must make one full turn. (Primitive dress encouraged but, not required).

# The Moustache Match

## Honoring Roy “Pa” Keeler



Roy “Pa” Keeler enjoyed muzzleloading arms. His main emphasis on any course of fire was having fun and spending time with folks who shared his love for the black powder shooting sports. Today, Pa Keeler is still known for the principles he lived by: honesty, integrity, friendship, sportsmanship and a devoted passion for preserving America’s rich muzzleloading heritage. Rare is the shoot that someone doesn’t ask, “Did ‘ya ever meet “Pa” Keeler?”

In 2017, the Spirit of Roy Keeler Society celebrated the anniversary of his 100th birthday with a special match and a commemorative patch. In honor of Pa Keeler, a stamped black moustache marked the rifle target or the shotgun score card. Someone called it “the moustache match,” and the name stuck. The response was tremendous—85 percent of the registered shooters took part.

Some folks adhered to the recommended two offhand shots and three from any rest position while others made up their own rules. Mothers and daughters, fathers and sons, grandparents and grandkids broke clay pigeons or punched holes together. Two old-timers shot for ice cream bars, others for quarters or just bragging rights. Scores weren’t kept and everyone had fun.

Many shooters asked if the match was going to be a yearly event, so the Spirit of Roy Keeler Society decided to sponsor a new version of The Moustache Match in 2019.

The Moustache Match is free to registered shooters at the Michigan State Muzzle Loading State Championship Rifle and Pistol Matches, the MSMLA State Shotgun Championships, the NMLRA’s Michigan Territorial Rifle and Pistol Matches and the Michigan Territorial Shotgun Matches. A new lapel pin, “Carrying on the Tradition—Roy “Pa” Keeler,” will be given to those shooters who turn in a completed target or shotgun score card.

To complete the rifle, pistol and smoothbore match, shooters will post a specially marked Moustache Match target at 50 yards, then fire two shots from any rest and three shots offhand. Any metallic iron sights are allowed, but no scopes. Inline rifles may be used, but all shots must be a patched round ball. The shotgun match will be five standard clay birds shot from ten yards. Muzzleloading shotguns must be used. All range and safety rules apply. This match is designed to have fun. Scores will not be kept or posted Complete the match and get a patch. It’s that simple!
