*There was another trip that stands out and that was when twelve of us Michiganders went to Maine to compete in the Maine Territorial Matches. That was an absolute blast. 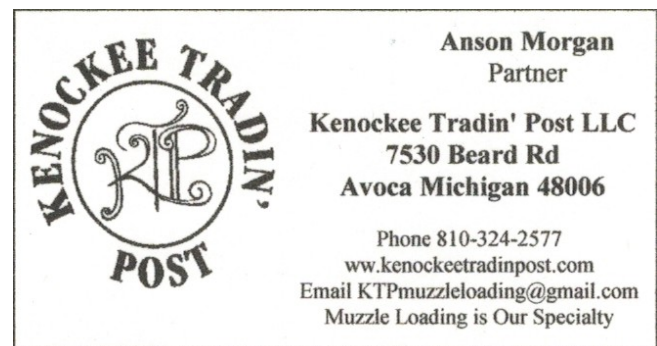

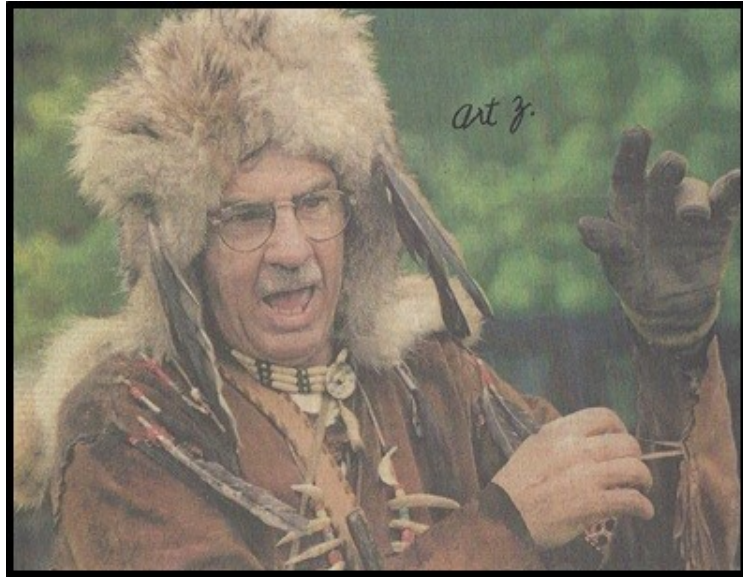
